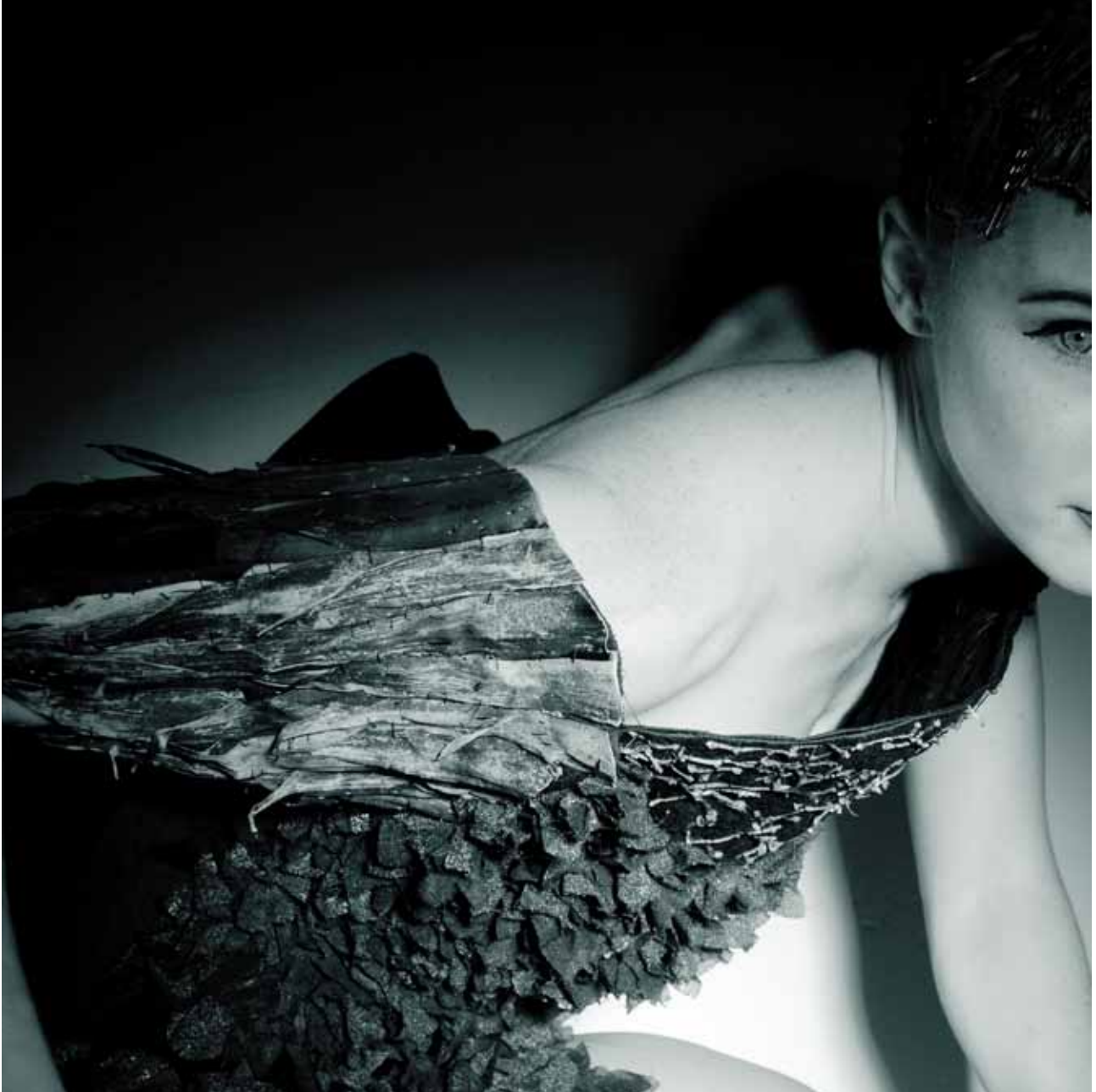

International competition

Fashion and Textile Design MA Degree

## Project briefing

Participants to the competition are asked to present a proposal for a nature-inspired fashion accessory: shapes and/or decorations should remind of nature.

The accessory should represent a sort of personal "statement" on nature as a topic, take into consideration its poetical aspects, or its overwhelming and destructive ones, depending on the participant's personal choice.

The material suggested for the accessory doesn't necessarily have to be natural.

## Deliverables

The proposal has to be submitted as a pdf or ppt file, including reference images for the project (maximum 5 images), be them sketches, pictures of a prototype or renderings, and a text presentation of the concept.

## Prizes

The authors of the two best projects delivered will be offered a partial scholarship covering the 50% of the tuition fee of the first year of the MA Degree in Fashion and Textile Design, starting in January 2012.

The scholarship will be confirmed for the second year if the student will comply with specific academic requirements (average grade not less than 27/30 and at least 40 credits awarded within the end of the fall exam session).

## Deadline and requirements

Projects and related attached documents have to be sent by post in closed envelope in order to reach NABA within July 15th 2011. The envelope has to be addressed to:

## Admission process

15th July 2011 - Materials have to reach NABA.

31st August 2011 - NABA will publish the scholarships awardees ranking and announce the winning project.

30th September 2011 - Winners have to enroll in the Fashion and Textile Design MA Degree, or they will lose

their rights on the scholarship.

30th November 2011 - All interested students have to enroll in the program.

13th January 2012 - Start of the courses.

## General conditions

- When receiving the materials, NABA will send an email of confirmation to the participant. If one week after having sent the materials, or in any case within the 15th of July, no email has been yet received, we advice students to contact the International Admissions Department by phone (02973721) or email (int.info@naba.it).
- Materials can be sent via express courier or regular mail (not recommended). Materials received by NABA after July 15th will not be considered valid.
- All projects and other materials submitted will not be returned to the entrant.
- NABA reserves itself the right to award scholarships only if the level of received projects will be considered of an appropriate quality level, according to the unchallengeable judgment of NABA evaluating commission.
- Scholarships can not be accumulated with other special terms or discounts offered by NABA, but they might be accumulated with scholarships/contributions from other organizations.

## MA Degree in Fashion and Textile Design

The program offers a complete training for fashion designers willing to develop advanced skills for covering high-level roles within the international fashion system, as well as launching their own fashion brand.

Working with internationally renowned professionals and lecturers, in a mix of theoretical classes, practical labs and project workshops, students develop an in-depth knowledge of all the steps of fashion design and production, from ideas development to the creation and promotion of a real collection, may it be within an international company or on an independent production basis.
